

Waste Oil Recycling with 3663

IPA are now working in partnership with 3663 not just for the supply of food products, but also for **waste oil collections**.

By recycling our waste oil with 3663, they are able to convert this to a B30 bio diesel mix (30% bio fuel and 70% diesel) which fuels the lorries that deliver to us. This means that we are actively reducing our impact on the environment by cutting down on emissions in our supply chain and recycling a waste product for free at the same time.

How much of an impact would IPA members' waste oil have?

If all IPA members had recycled all the waste oil from the last 12 months with 3663, this would have created enough bio diesel (B30 mix) to save **over 80 tonnes of carbon*** being emitted into the environment, that is a **23% reduction** compared to normal diesel! So let's get started now and put our waste oil to good use.

What do you need to do to start recycling with 3663?

3663 use the nationwide collection company, Arrow to collect waste oil on their behalf. You have been sent a form to return to Arrow which asks you whether you would like a regular collection, or whether you would prefer to call them each time you need one. If you should require a collection outside of your agreed collection days, then you can contact them directly on **01706 627 772** - please quote '3663' at the time of the call to ensure your waste oil is recycled in this scheme.

Are collections free?

Yes

What is the minimum collection amount?

Minimum collection quantity is **60 litres**.

What do I recycle my oil in?

Ideally you should return the waste oil in the container it was delivered in. If you are unable to do this, then the collectors can provide you with a free on loan plastic barrel for storage outside - please contact Arrow directly on **01706 627 772** to arrange this.

What do I do if my previous collector comes for my waste oil?

If you have been recycling your waste oil with Arrow, then there is no change, and Arrow will continue to collect your oil and recycle it as part of the 3663 scheme. If any other collector has been calling for your oil, please advise them that you no longer require them to collect from you.

*This calculation is based on 60% of the volume of cooking oil delivered into all IPA members' units between 01/07/08 - 30/06/09 being disposed of as waste cooking oil and converted into bio fuel which is used as a B30 Bio Diesel mix. The saving is based on the carbon emissions of standard diesel versus B30 bio diesel mix for the amount of B30 fuel made with your quantity of waste oil.
